

Youth Convention 1992:

WOSY had organised a two day International Youth Convention, in Delhi on 25-26 of July 1992. This convention delivered the message to the world youth to strive for evolving a new world order free from exploitation, injustice, discrimination and violence. This convention held at New Convocation Hall of Delhi University was attended by 123 students and youth delegates including 72 foreign delegates from 12 countries such as USA, UK, Nigeria, Kenya, Myanmar, Mauritius, Tibet & Sudan.

Shri Eduardo Fallerio, the then Union Minister of State for External Affairs inaugurated the convention. Shir Shivraj Patil, the then Speaker of Lok Sabha and India's Union minister for Home Affairs, chaired the symposium on "The UN at the Cross - Roads". Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee, then a former Union Minister and a leader of opposition and later the Prime Minister of India was the Chief Guest at the Concluding session of this International Convention.

The theme of the Convention was "Youth for a New World". Group discussion on various aspects of this theme a symposium and a special talk by Shri A.P. Venkateshwaran, former foreign secretary of India, on "World at the turn of Century" were held. This convention is a milestone in the annals of WOSY activity.
